
O servant of the One True God! The Lord be praised, the loved ones of God are found in e - -very land,

and ours to hold fast to such means as shall ensure a fu-ller out-pouring of His grace and a




greater measure of His divine assi - -stance. One of the greatest of these means is the




spirit of true fellow- ship and loving communion among the friends. Remember the saying:






