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# Performance Notes

In the *Song Of The Immortal Youth* parts one and two, the music found herein is an attempt to set texts which are inherently mystical into melody. The text describes the efflorescence of a new Manifestation of God - The Báb - in the world of the Spirit, and the opportunity for mankind to believe in Him. A new Revelation from God is proclaimed by the inhabitants of heaven.

A *Song Cycle From The Writings Of The Báb* announces the advent of the Báb, the “Remembrance of God”, and then proclaims the imminent advent of “Him Whom God shall make manifest”, the “Remnant of God”, Bahá'u'lláh. It ends with the promise of the Báb to be, in Spirit, with those who visit His shrine.
