Composer's note: This is the original version. The CD "Songs of the Ancient Beauty, Vol. 2" used an alternative, paradoxical ending in which the "one step" is taken, the piece returning to and arriving at the key of D Major. Meanwhile, the text will forever imply "We're not there yet - just one more step to go", reflected in the original ending, one 'perfect' step away from the traditional home key.
